Pastor Herberth Fernandes and Team - Hebron Evangelical Church, Manaus



In the months of January, February and March, the city of Manaus experienced extremely difficult days due to the pandemic of

COVID-19. A devastating wave of widespread infection, lack of hospital structure, lack of ICU beds, lack of oxygen and medication has created public health chaos with a large number of daily deaths, desperate people, bereaved families and very sad days.







We are so thankful to the Lord for those, who through Acre Gospel Mission, felt led to give so generously to help us help others. So many hundreds of people have been reached out to here in the city of Manaus through your generosity. We have been distributing in various places in the city of Manaus to needy families giving out food hampers, medicines for the treatment of COVID-19, prevention products such as sanitiser and masks and oxygen cylinder kits to help in the treatment of the disease, since many were treated at home. We also helped out financially with funeral expenses for poor families that had lost loved ones. We also have also been able to reach people out in the Leprosarium, in the elderly people's shelter and orphanage.



In each home we visited, we were able to leave literature and also share from God's Word. We have also been able to send aid to the interior towns of the State of Amazonas such as Canutama and Maués where we have teams working along side us.

We want to say a very big thank you for all who have participaited in this ministry, following the example of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ in Matthew 9: 35 - "And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom and healing every sickness and every disease among the people."

They were also able to hire out a small boat to travel on the river to those who had lost everything in the floods. Pastor Antoildson and the team packed up over 300 food parcels and water containers to travel the four-hour journey on extremely dangerous roads from Rio Branco to Boca Do Acre at the beginning of March. They had great opportunities of reaching many families not only in the town but also along the river. The severe flooding meant that many people had lost their homes and were living in communal military tents or even in their canoes. Because of this Covid 19 spread rapidly across the town. Please continue to pray for these families as they rebuild their homes and for those who have been ill and for the families who have lost loved ones due to the virus.



Pastor Antoildson and most of the team that travelled to Boca Do Acre contracted Covid19 and were extremely ill. Pastor Antoildson was in hospital for a number of days as was Alfonso. This photo is when Pastor Antoildson was released from hospital. Please pray for him as he now recovers at home. Pray for Alfonso, Paula, Nilzomar and Cassiano who were also members of the team and have all been sick with Covid.

Churches are not back yet with face to face services. The new varients of Covid19 in Brazil are very strong and do not respect colour, sex or social class. Many in the churches are ill. Thank you for your prayers.

"We arrived back in town in March only to find the river overflowing its banks. The town is totally flooded and our house was swamped. I am glad to say the river level is now going down. The church had been closed because of the pandemic but next Sunday we hope to open the church to receive the congregation indoors. Because the church was flooded we have to do a major clean before we can have our services there. We ask you please to pray for us. After the floods there is always epidemics of dysentery and other illnesses. We are trusting of God will keep us all safe and continue to bless us in the work of the gospel. We have been able to also distribute aid
